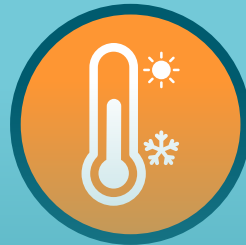

Resistant to corrosion and buildup



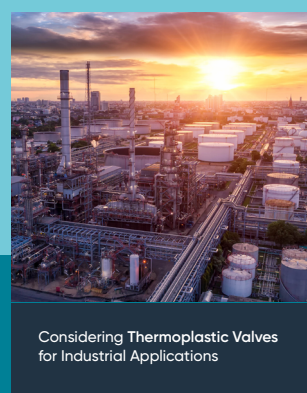
Easier to install and repair since they weight less than metal and don't require special installation training or tools
